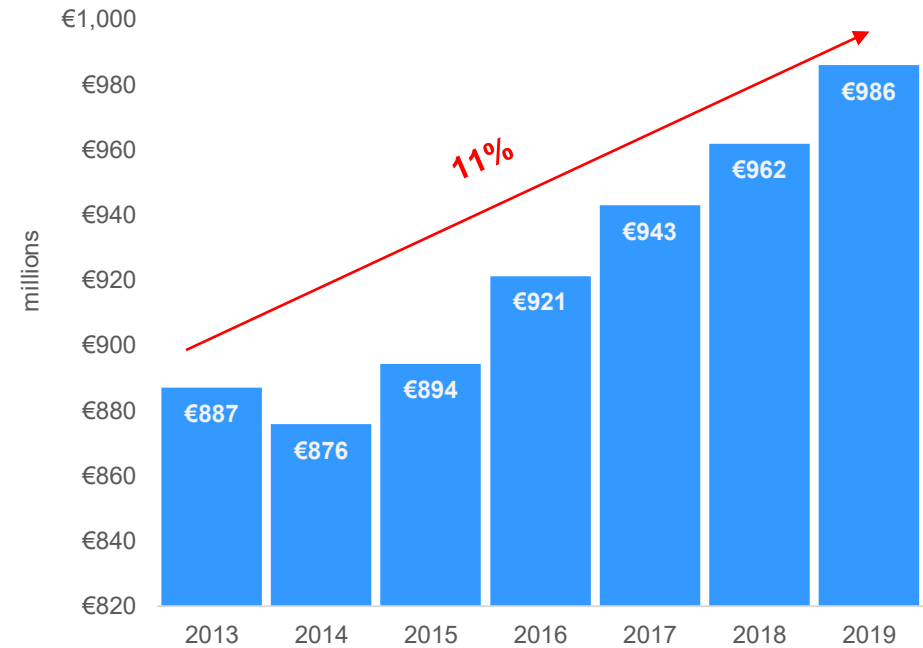
# The Nursing Home Support Scheme Fair Deal

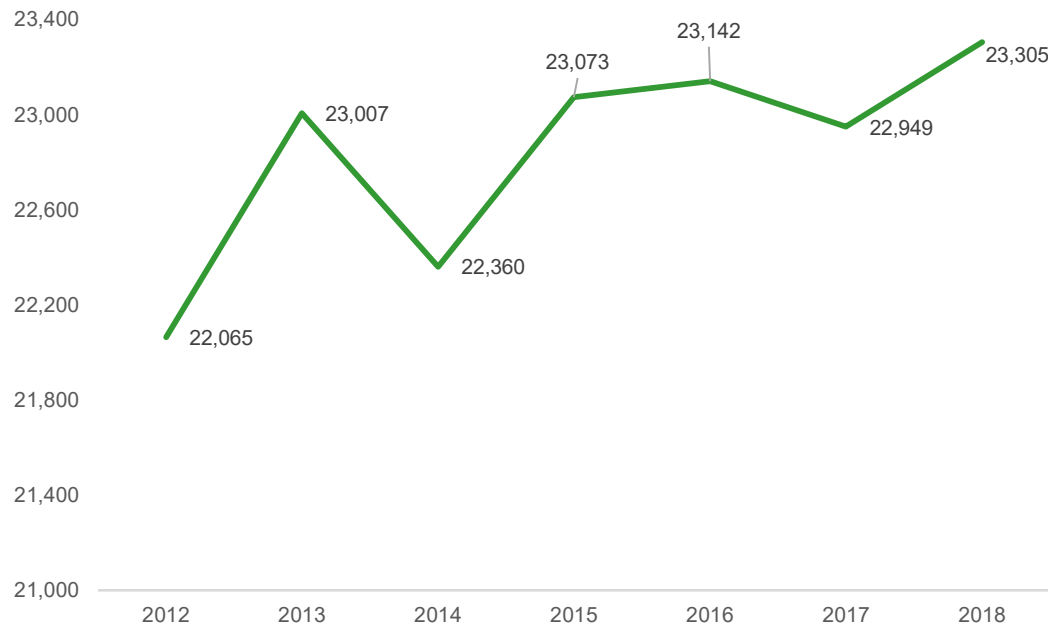

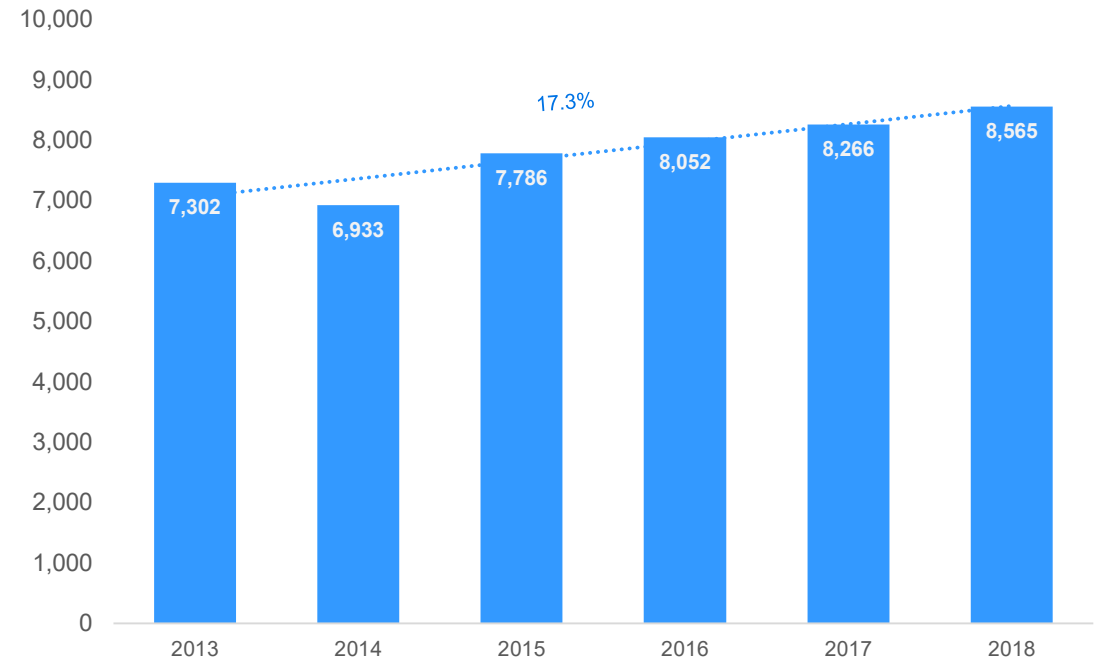
# Numbers funded and Exits

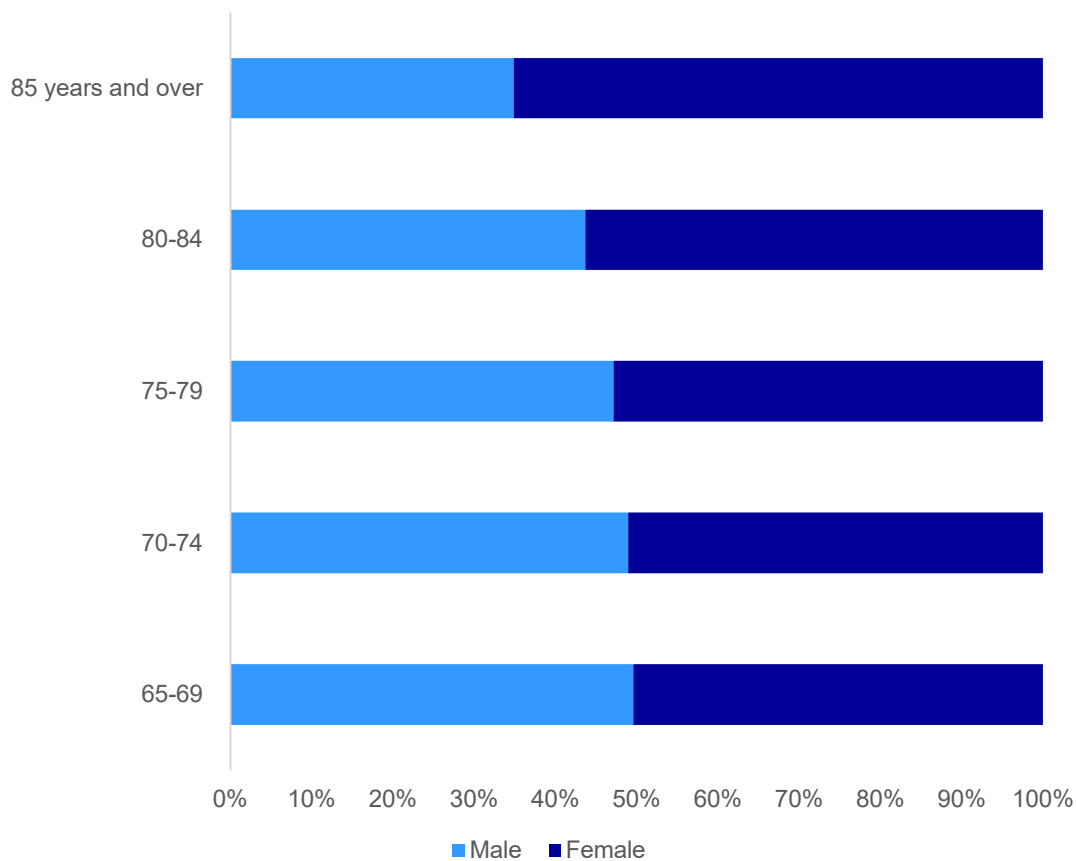

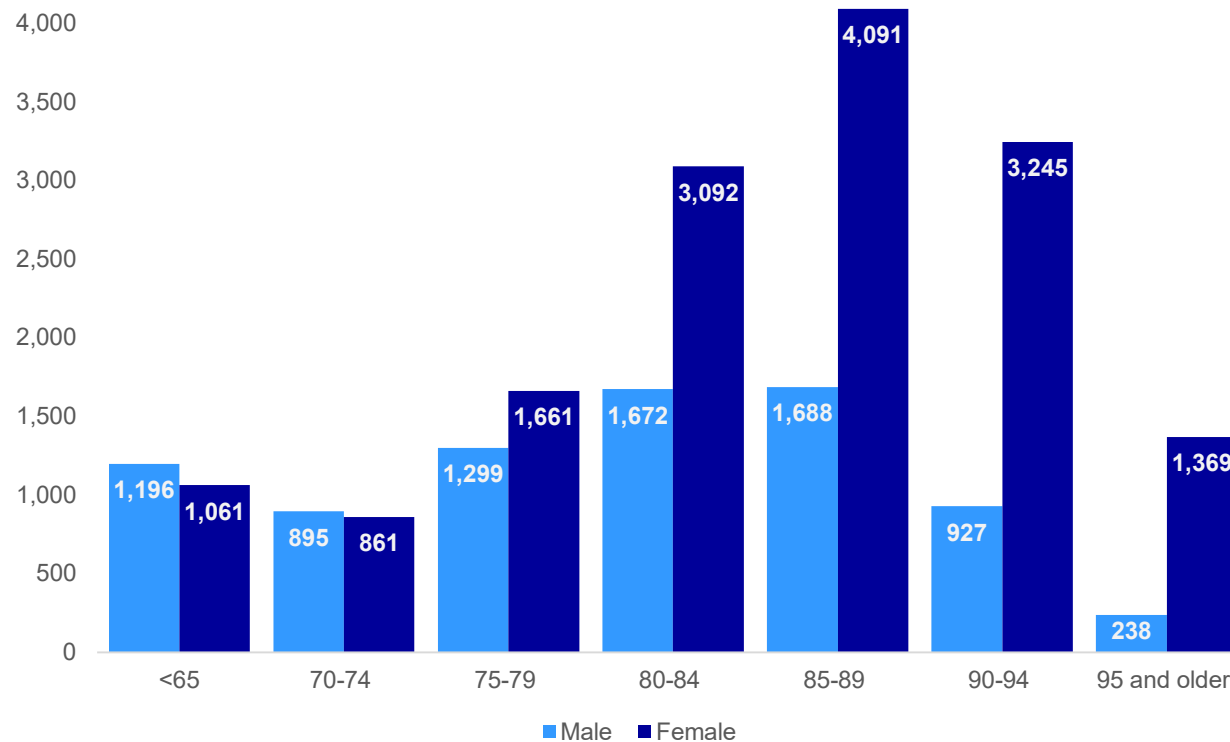


Older population by sex and age group, 2017

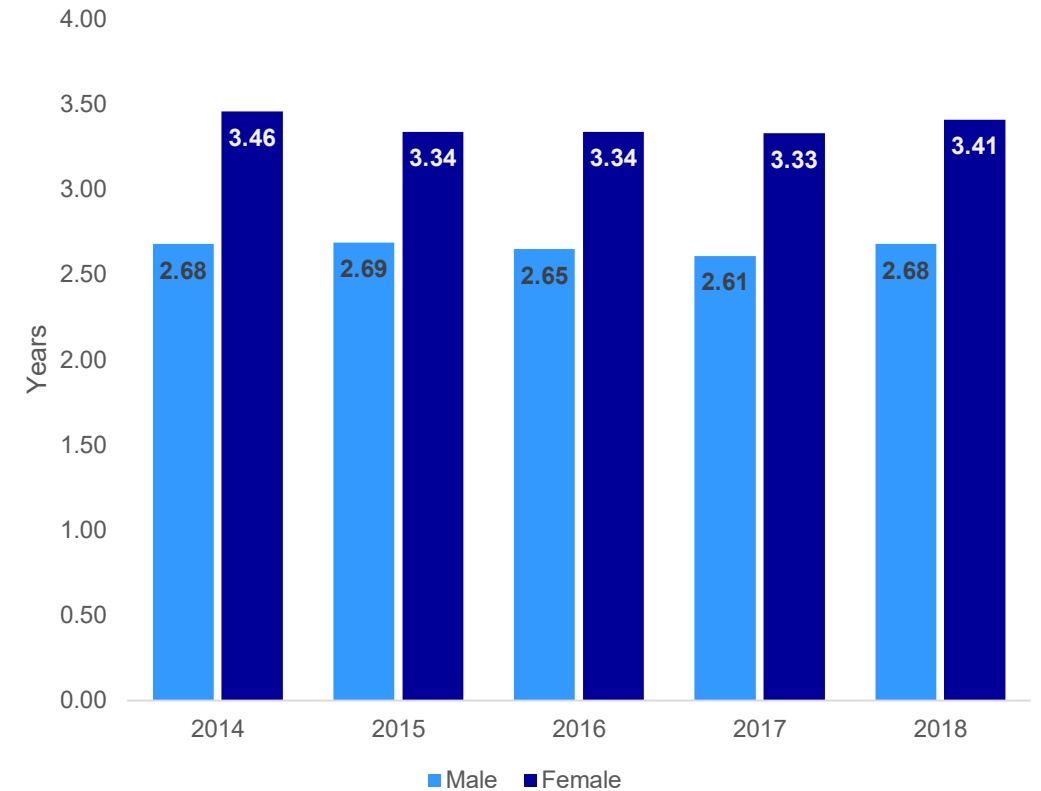

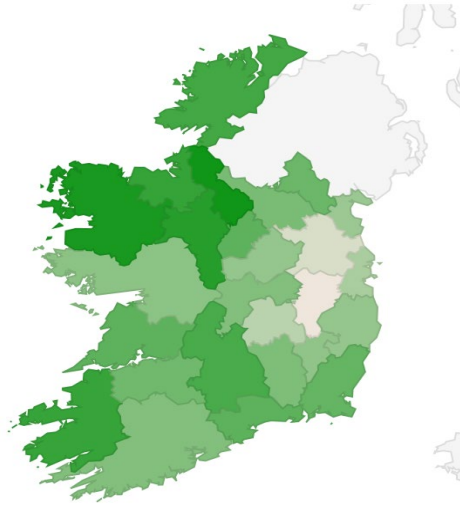

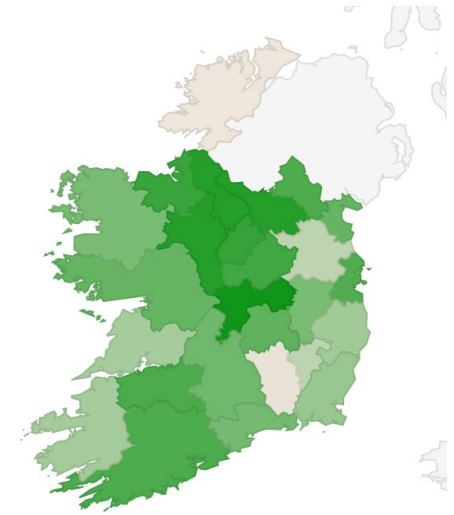


Elderly population as % of county population

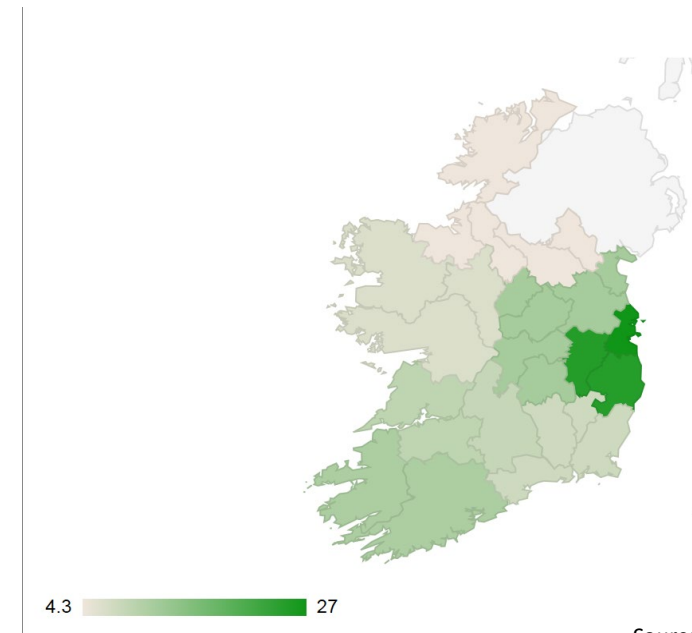

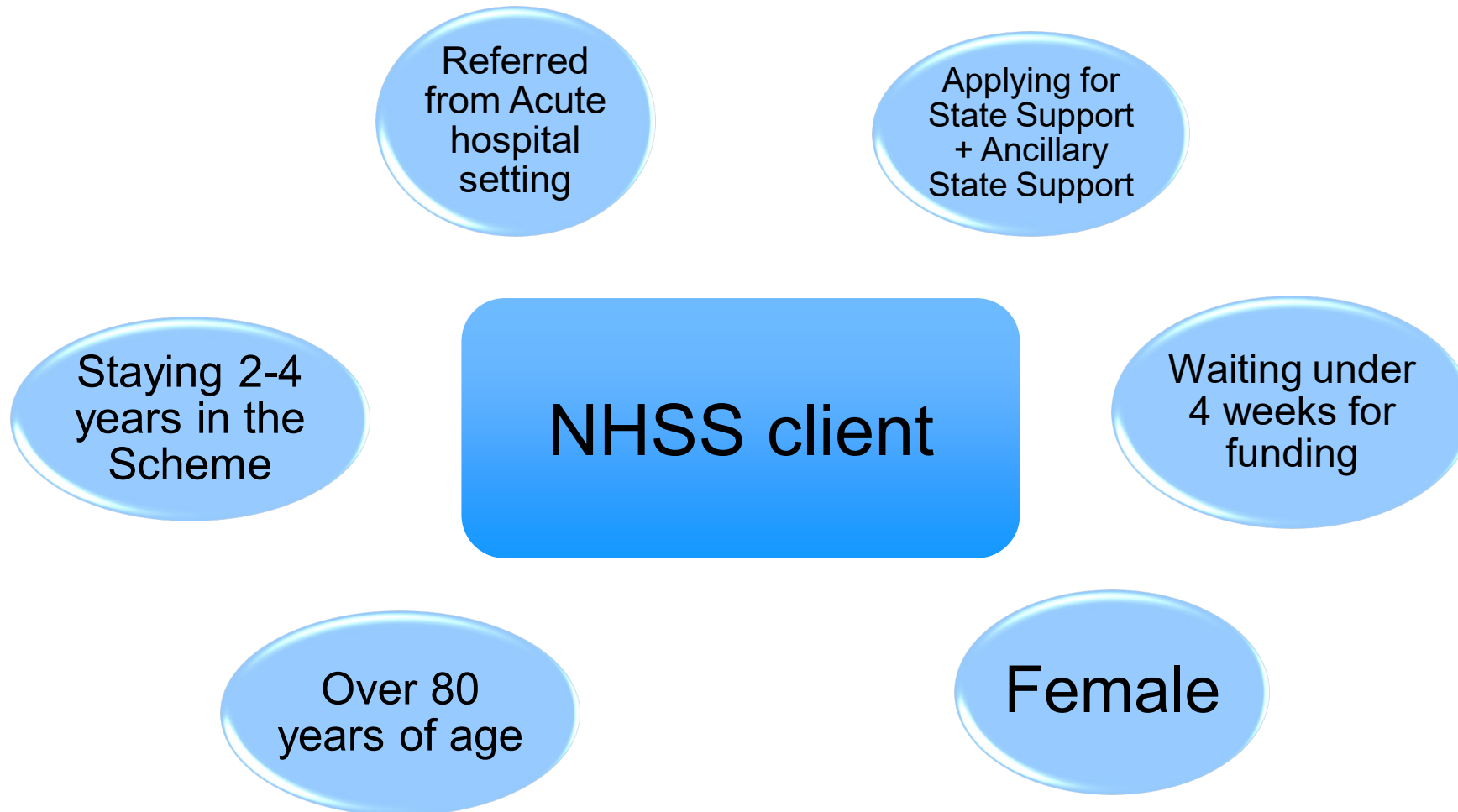
