### Are you a resettled refugee in Ireland?

We are looking for refugees resettled in Ireland through the resettlement programme (Irish Refugee Protection Programme or IRPP) to complete a survey about their experiences in Ireland.

### Who can take part?

You can take part in this survey, if you

- came to Ireland under **the Refugee Resettlement Programme** since 2015,
- are **18 years or older**, and
- are willing to share your experiences of the programme in Ireland. We also ask about housing, education, health etc.

### Who is conducting this research?

This research is being carried out by The Economic and Social Research Institute, and has been commissioned by the Irish Refugee Resettlement Programme within the Department of Justice, Migration and Home Affairs.



## HOW TO TAKE PART?

### Step 1

To take part, you will be sent a link to a survey by someone in your local community.

Once you receive the link, you will have the option to complete the survey online, or over the phone.

### Step 2

After completing the survey, you will be asked to share the link with up to 3 other IRPP refugees you know, who then share it with 3 more people, and the chain continues.

### Step 3

If you receive a link, please complete the survey and **pass it on!**

The more responses we get, the better we will be able to understand the experiences of IRPP refugees in Ireland.
