
It is vital that children with disabilities have equal access to early childhood care and education

#### **MEASUREMENT OF DISABILITY IS COMPLEX**

Using Census 2016 data, 4.5% of 3-5-year-olds were reported as having a disability

Using Growing Up Ireland data, the disability rate amongst those aged 5 is estimated at 8.8%





#### **CHILDHOOD DISABILITY RATES VARY BY COUNTY**

Higher than average: Offaly, Limerick, Laois, Carlow

Lower than average: Leitrim, Roscommon, Galway, Sligo
