



## ESTIMATED MONTHLY MODIFIED DOMESTIC DEMAND (MDD)

28 October 2022





MDD is a measure of domestic economic activity in Ireland including spending by households, investment by enterprises and net spending by the government.



Monthly MDD has been strong through 2022, although growth has slowed since it's Y-on-Y peak of 14% in February 2022. Monthly MDD in August 2022 is estimated to be 4.0% above its level in August 2021. MDD for Q3 2023 is now estimated to be 4.1% on an annual basis.
