



ESTIMATED MONTHLY MODIFIED DOMESTIC DEMAND (MDD)

16 December 2022



MDD is a measure of domestic economic activity in Ireland including spending by households, investment by enterprises and net spending by the government.



On a monthly basis, MDD growth has slowed for four consecutive months. On an annual basis, MDD in October 2022 grew 3.1%. MDD for Q4 2022 is now estimated to be 2.4% on an annual basis.
