


ESTIMATED MONTHLY MODIFIED DOMESTIC DEMAND (MDD)

November 2022 MDD: 2.5%



MDD is a measure of domestic economic activity in Ireland including spending by households, investment by enterprises and net spending by the government.

MODIFIED DOMESTIC DEMAND (MDD) NOWCAST



On a monthly basis, MDD growth has slowed for five consecutive months. On an annual basis, MDD in November 2022 grew 2.5%. For Q4 2022, MDD is now estimated to have grown 2.4% on an annual basis.
